

## PLAT OF SURVEY

That part of the NW, NE, SE and SW 1/4s of the SW 1/4 of Section 27, Town 2 North, Range 7 East, Township of Monroe, Green County, Wisconsin, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the W 1/4 corner of Section 27; thence S89\*42'06"E along the N. line of the SW 1/4 of Section 27, 53.85' to the point of beginning; thence S89\*42'06"E along said N. line, 1306.15'; thence S0°59'50"W, 1429.77'; thence S89°00'10"E, 263.33'; thence S0°59'50"W, 304.81' to the northerly right—of—way of S.T.H. 11; thence S36°28'05"W along said northerly right—of—way, 383.61'; thence Southwesterly, 534.19' along said northerly right—of—way and the arc of a curve to the right, whose radius is 2754.79' and whose chord bears \$42°01'24"W, 533.35'; thence \$45°27'43"W along said northerly right-of-way, 263.20'; thence \$43°51'34"W along said northerly right-of-way, 18.10' to the \$5. line of the \$5W 1/4 of Section 27; thence N89'49'36"W along S. line, 840.98' to the easterly right-of-way of C.T.H. N; thence N5'57'29"E along said easterly right-of-way, 347.19'; thence N4'55'29"W along said easterly right—of—way, 187.18'; thence N6°17'43"E along said easterly right—of—way, 315.50'; thence N0°51'35"E along said easterly right—of—way, 200.05'; thence N4°38'08"W along said easterly right-of-way, 300.94'; thence N15°36'06"E along said easterly right-of-way, 103.05'; thence N4°22'06"E along said easterly right-of-way, 100.11'; thence N9°44'16"W along said easterly right—of—way, 154.65'; thence N2\*35'25"E along said easterly right—of—way, 186.00'; thence N18\*08'14"E along said easterly right—of—way, 66.22'; thence N1\*59'43"E along said easterly right—of—way, 199.96'; thence N5°40'36"W along said easterly right—of—way, 228.71'; thence N7°05'54"E along said easterly right—of—way, 145.86'; thence N5°52'23"E along said easterly right-of-way, 128.44' to the point of beginning; subject to any and all easements of record.
