
PLAT OF SURVEY

That part of the W 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Section 29 and the N 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 32, Town 3 North, Range 7 East, Township of Washington, Green County, Wisconsin, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the S 1/4 corner of Section 29; thence N0°18'58"E along the W. line of the SE 1/4 of Section 29, 1135.73'; thence S89°52'34"E along the S. line of the N. forty—six (46) Acres of the W 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Section 29, 1327.76' to the E. line of the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 29; thence S0°09'08"W along said E. line, 1135.15'; thence S2°15'00"E along the E. line of the NW 1/4 of Section 32, 661.18'; thence N89°58'03"W along the S. line of the N 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 32, 1328.18' to the W. line of the NE 1/4 of Section 32; thence N2°29'20"W along said W. line, 662.85' to the point of beginning; subject to a public road right—of—way as shown and to any and all easements of record.

support Mr. Talarczyks location as well and that the straight line intersection fit well with existing occupation.
