

PLAT OF SURVEY

The NE & NW 1/4s of the NW 1/4 of Section 33, part of the NE & NW 1/4s of the NE 1/4 of Section 32 and part of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 29, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, Town of Washington, Green County, Wisconsin, bounded and described as follows:

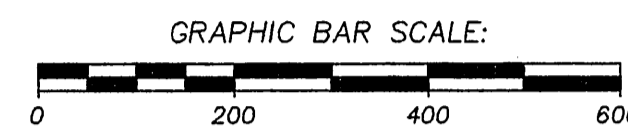
Beginning at the NW corner of Section 33; thence N89°25'04"E along the North line of the NW 1/4 of Section 33, 2654.05'; thence S2°02'44"E along the East line of the NW 1/4 of Section 33, 1325.91'; thence S89°33'56"W along the South line of the NE & NW 1/4s of the NW 1/4 of Section 33, 2655.05'; thence N76°10'02"W, 1502.66' to the centerline of Church Road; thence N23°38'12"E along said centerline, 169.46'; thence Northeasterly, 148.60' along said centerline and the arc of a curve to the left, whose radius is 267.00' and whose chord bears N7°41'32"E, 146.69' to the South line of the N 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 32; thence S89°58'03"E along the South lines of the N 1/2 of the NE & NW 1/4s of the NE 1/4 of Section 32, 120.00'; thence N33°42'00"E, 197.91'; thence N42°54'00"E, 200.00'; thence N49°42'00"E, 380.00'; thence N32°08'00"E, 310.00'; thence N38°40'00"E, 310.00'; thence S48°10'00"E, 210.00'; thence S1°32'00"E, 160.00'; thence S8°46'00"W, 104.00' to the South line of the SE 1/4 of Section 29; thence S89°54'02"E along said South line, 166.00' to the point of beginning; subject to a public road right-of-way as shown and to any and all easements of record.

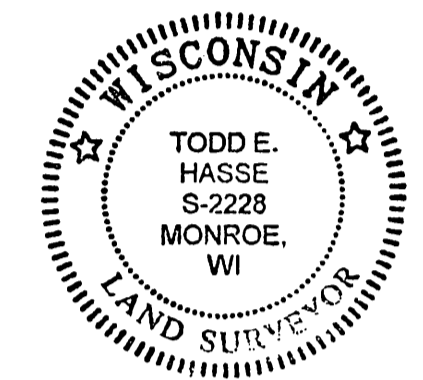
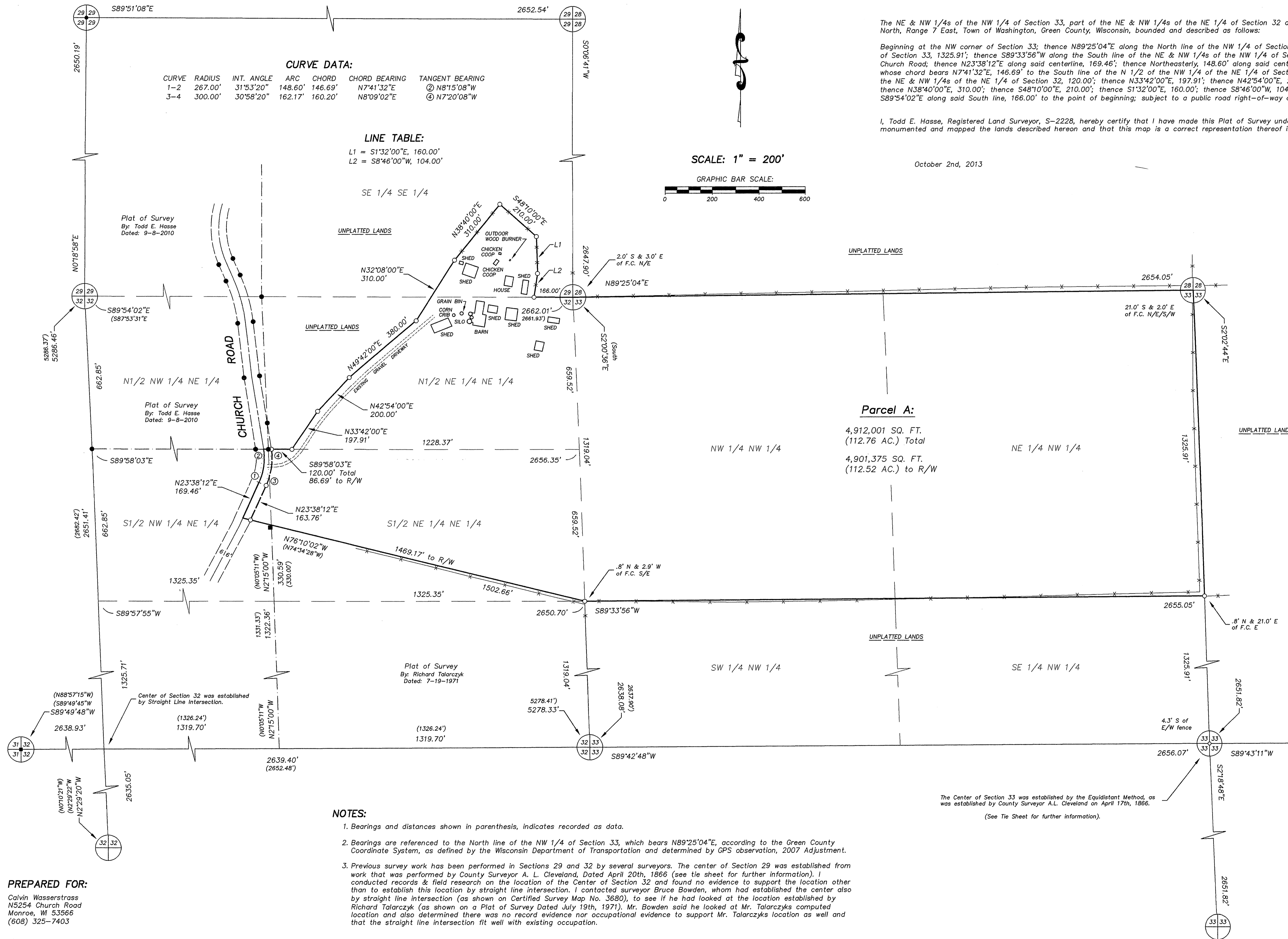

 - Bearings are referenced to the North line of the NW 1/4 of Section 33, which bears N89°25'04"E, according to the Green County Coordinate System, as defined by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation and determined by GPS observation, 2007 Adjustment.
 - Previous survey work has been performed in Sections 29 and 32 by several surveyors. The center of Section 29 was established from work that was performed by County Surveyor A. L. Cleveland, Dated April 20th, 1866 (see tie sheet for further information). I conducted records & field research on the location of the Center of Section 32 and found no evidence to support the location other than to establish this location by straight line intersection. I contacted surveyor Bruce Bowden, whom had established the center also by straight line intersection (as shown on Certified Survey Map No. 3680), to see if he had looked at the location established by Richard Talarczyk (as shown on a Plat of Survey Dated July 19th, 1971). Mr. Bowden said he looked at Mr. Talarczyk's computed location and also determined there was no record evidence nor occupational evidence to support Mr. Talarczyk's location as well and that the straight line intersection fit well with existing occupation.
